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**AMIDOPYRIN IN MEASLES.**

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The amidopyrin was given in aqueous solution in doses of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  to 3 grains four-hourly until the temperature remained normal for twenty-four hours, dosage being varied proportionately to age. The cases were not selected. The use of amidopyrin was begun with the third batch of cases—namely, the ninth case—and was thereafter given to every alternate case. Careful notes and charts were kept of all cases.
