The children on admission were placed in two groups upon Diets I and II, care being taken that the infants in each group should be as similar as possible in age, general condition, and development, and that they should remain under identical conditions of general management and hygiene during their stay in hospital. The children in the two dietetic groups occupied adjoining cots in the wards, so that differences in the degree of illumination and exposure to fresh air were minimized as much as possible.
