In order further to eliminate variable factors as much as possible the following measures were taken. The cases were allotted to the three groups in strict rotation. In each ward in which the investigations were conducted the groups received the same nursing attention—a factor which may be of some importance. As all the cases were admitted during the same period the seasonal factor was eliminated. All cases were under the care of the same medical officer, who made an assessment of the severity of each case and an examination for the presence of complications.
