XXII. *Remarks on the Amputations of the larger Extremities; by the same.*

This Operation of Amputation consists in a proper Precaution to prevent any Hæmorrhagy during the Operation; cutting all the soft Parts, which cover the Bone or Bones; sawing it or them through; securing the cut Vessels from bleeding afterwards; and dressing so as to promote a safe and easy Cure. In this Order then I shall make my Remarks.

The Physicians and Surgeons of the *Royal Infirmary* here have always followed the Method above-mentioned, and have not lost one Patient of fourteen who have had Amputations of the larger Extremities performed.
