TREATMENT OF ANGINA PECTORIS BY TESTOSTERONE PROPIONATE

To rule out as far as possible the psychotherapeutic effect of the injection itself, regardless of what the product might be, a control was used in 6 cases. These patients received injections of the testosterone propionate in sesame oil for a period of about four weeks, alternated by a similar period when only sesame oil was used. The ampules all looked exactly alike and the patient was not aware of what he was getting. In some of these cases the testosterone propionate injections were again resumed after sesame oil alone was used over a certain period.
